4. Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

(i) 4-Year UG Degree (Honours/ Honours with Research): A Student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards/ Councils with at least four Subjects including English as Compulsory subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the UG –Courses of studies on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subjects(s) of the concerned college.
